

## Bylaw 2023-01

## **Zone Bylaw – Amendment**

A bylaw of the Town of Eston in the Province of Saskatchewan to amend Bylaw 2017-12, *The Zoning Bylaw*, for the Town of Eston.

The Council of the Town of Eston, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw 2017-12 as follows:

1. Definitions is amended by adding the follow new definitions.

"Short-Term Homestay: The provision of sleeping, bathing and cooking quarters within a dwelling unit that is the principal residence of the host, which is used to provide rental accommodations to guests for tenancies of one day or more."

**"Short-Term Rental:** A dwelling unit which is not the principal residence of the host, but is used to provide rental accommodations to guests for tenancies of one day or more"

2. Discretionary Use Standards for Development is amended by adding the following new subsection:

## Short-Term Rental

- No alteration shall be made to the external appearance of any principal or accessory structures that is
  inconsistent to the residential character of the neighbourhood.
- Short-Term Rentals shall meet the off-street parking requirements of the district in which they are located within.
- Short-Term Rentals shall not exceed more than:
  - 6 guests when located within a single detached dwelling.
  - 3 guests when located within a secondary suite.
- Guest rooms shall not contain cooking facilities.
- Council may revoke discretionary use approval if, in council's opinion, the operation of the Short-Term Rental is causing a significant impact on the residential character of the neighbourhood.
- 3. Discretionary Uses, Principal Uses is amended by adding the following new principal use: "Short-term rental."
- 4. Discretionary Uses, Principal Uses is amended by adding the following new principal use: "Short-term rental."
